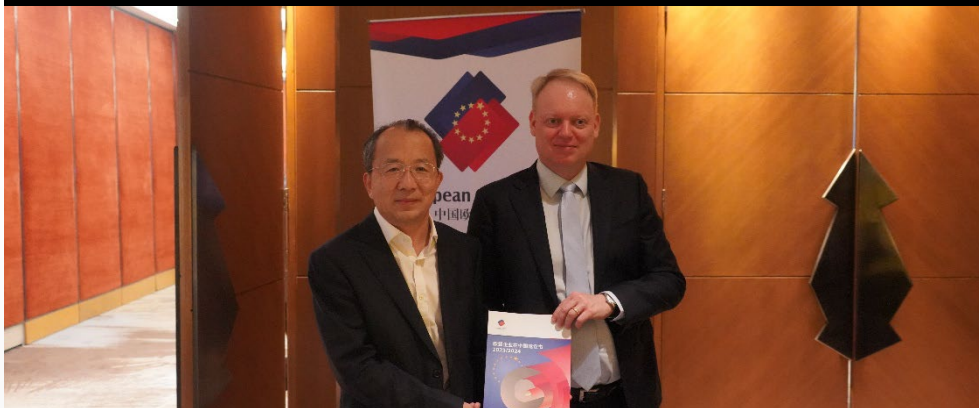

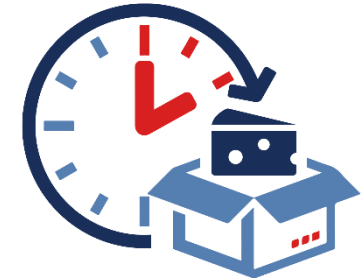
The four-year extension of the individual income tax (IIT) regime for foreign nationals until the end of 2027.

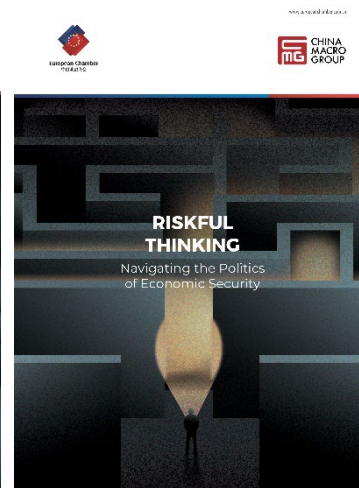

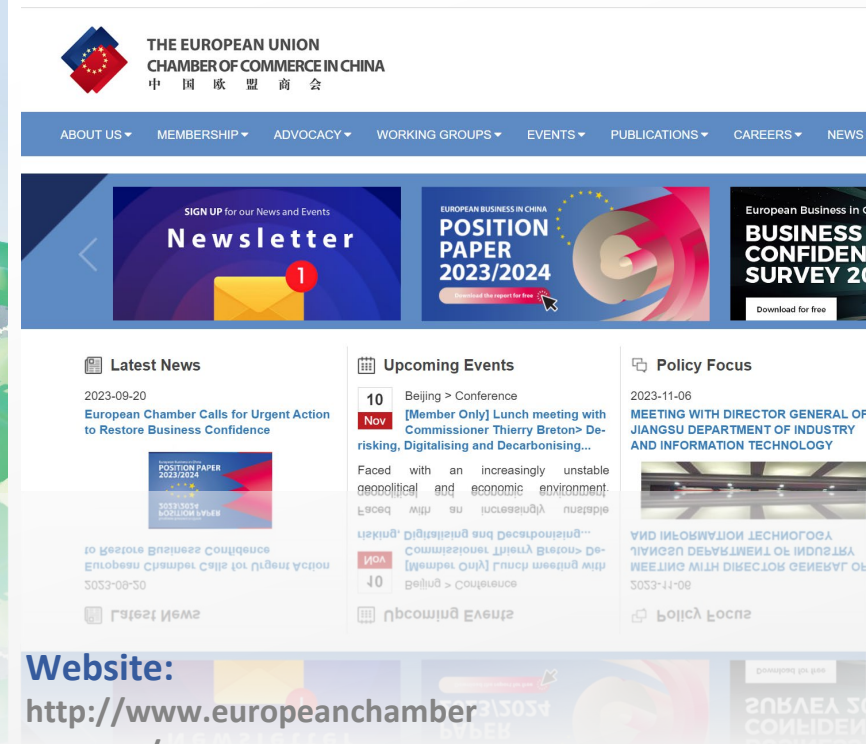

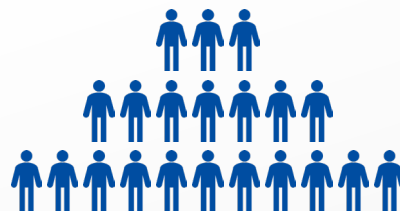
