Dr Min Tang was born on December 24, 1953. He Executive Vice President of YouCheng Foundation, Counselor of the State Council Counselor's Office, and the 5th Special Inspector of the Ministry of Supervision. Vice Chairman of the Graduate School of the People's Bank of China. Adjunct professor at the Central Party School, Peking University, Wuhan University, and Jinan University. Consultant of the Financial Advisory Group of Beijing Municipal Government and Guangzhou Municipal Government, member of the China Economic Fifty People Forum, and director of the Chamber of Commerce of the European and American Alumni Association. Graduated from the Department of Mathematics of Wuhan University. He taught at the

Department of Economics and Management of Wuhan University from 1982 to 1984. From 1984 to 1989, he was a Ph.D. in the Department of Economics at the University of Illinois at Urban Champaign. From 1989 to 2007. He has served as an economist at the Economic Development Research Center of the Asian Development Bank. He is responsible for East Asian economics, inter-regional economic cooperation, Asian debt, and Asian financial markets. The Asian Development Bank's representative in China, also the deputy and chief economist. From September 2007 to September 2010, he served as the deputy secretary-general of the China Development Foundation of the Development Research Center of the State Council. From September 2010 to present, he served as the executive director of the State Council and the executive vice chairman of YouCheng Foundation.
